The Laboratory of Research in Arid Zones in partnership with the Algerian Association of Experimental Animal Sciences (AASEA) will organize African Conference in June 2023 in order to establish the education and training needs in the field of laboratory animal science in Africa and to develop targeted solutions to address these needs.
